PARD INDIA has been implementing community-driven educational programs under the "Village Education Improvement Project" since the commencement of our services in 2011, renamed as "Rural Education and Development (READ) Project" in 2020, focusing primarily on the development of deprived children (V-kids who are hailing from a rural background and are often denied with the equal opportunities in their upbringing, study environment and exposure to the competitive world) and their families and communities.
